

COMPARING THE 2 TYPES OF SOFTWARE



PIM focuses on managing and improving product data and distributing that data.

> PIMs are built to handle many attributes with validation rules in place and attribute typing.



ERP focuses on managing and improving all sales-related business processes such as purchasing, manufacturing. and warehouse management.

> ERPs do not have the same capabilities for consolodating accurate and consistent product data.

PIMs are built to edit, enchance and distribute product data and many of these processes are automated. ERPs do not have the same level of automation or enhancements for product data as they are not built for this purpose.

OneTimePIM allows you to store the same products in different ways (like different langauages or for different websites). ERPs do not usually have this functionality and also struggle with parent products and their variants.
